## **Prague Airport to expand taxi services**

Uber currently provides taxi services at Václav Havel Airport in Prague. The concession to provide the service runs until 25th September 2028. Prague Airport is working to satisfy the demand of a group of passengers who want to use classic taxis without the need to provide any personal data. In September, preliminary market consultations with providers were held. If it is introduced, this will be an additional service that will not be provided in the first lanes by the terminals.

### Leo Express launches 5G wifi

Free wifi on board Leo Express trains is nothing more than you would expect. But now, with the launch of a 5G network the speed has just got a lot faster - internet connection on journeys has gone from 60 to almost 100%. The average daily data consumption of just one train has grown from 61 to 313 GB – a rise of 400% - and the highest daily consumption of a single train was 1.3TB, the equivalent of 300 films in HD quality. The upgrade is the first milestone in a Leo Express digital transformation plan which will be followed by the launch of an online refreshment ordering system.

## Prague bans night pub crawls

Prague city council has approved an amendment to the business regulations that will limit pub crawls. Between the hours of 22:00 and 6:00 this kind of organised "walk" will be banned across the city. "We decided on the amendment to the business regulations on the initiative of Prague 1 council, a neighbourhood where pub crawls have brought many negative impacts on public spaces, the local economy and community relations. Large groups of tourists taking part in these events produce more litter and place greater stress on the security services which places a disproportionate burden on municipal infrastructure, the city's street cleaning services and the city police," stated Adam Zábranský, member of the city council.

#### **Gothic Trail in South Bohemia**

The South Bohemia Tourist Board, the Aleš Gallery, the České Budějovice Bishopric, the South Bohemia Regional development agency– RERA and the Tourismusverband Mühlviertler Alm Freistadt have come together to work on a project called Gothic Trail Mühlviertel – South Bohemia (AT-CZ). This aims to promote and make more accessible Gothic cultural heritage and Gothic art. The project will strive to develop the Gothic trail concept, making it into a comprehensive tourist product in the shape of cross-border hiking trails, modern sustainable options for hikers and a wider range of cultural offerings.

#### **Elbe Trail adds another section**

Another section has been completed near the village of Nučnice between Roudnice nad Labem and Litoměřice on the Elbe Trail, one of the most popular cycle paths in Czechia. This was financed by the Ústí Region and the finished section was handed over at the beginning of October. For cyclists this not only means increased comfort and better riding but also safety as the route avoids existing roads. "This kilometre-long section will ensure greater safety for cyclists who up until now had to ride along a minor road that is used by quite a lot of traffic. In addition to the cycling trail itself, a completely new bridge has been built across the Úštěcký Stream which replaces the existing structure which had fallen into disrepair," stated Tomáš Rieger, councillor responsible for investment.

# **Greenway Jizera cycle trail gains new section from Turnov to Svijany**

In 2026, cyclists could see the opening of a new section of the Greenway Jizera trail from Turnov to Svijany via the villages of Modřišice, Přepeře, Všeň and Příšovice. Regional councillors have approved the launch of a public tender for the project. The final cost is not permitted to exceed 44,799,149.93 Czech crowns including VAT. In addition to the regional authorities, some of the above-mentioned local communities will also share the cost. The section is 9.208km long and the project will be split into two parts – the first section from Turnov to Přepeře will be completed in 2025 and the second the following year.

## New caravan sites in the region

The Zlín Regional Assembly has agreed to requests to support four projects, the aim of which is to provide better facilities for visitors who arrive in the region in caravans and campervans. The sum of 2.2 million crowns that the region will distribute among those concerned will go towards the creation of three new caravan sites and a separate service point. "We have approved financing which will fund new caravan sites at Újezd, Liptál and Uherský Brod. In Vsetín an independent service point will be built where caravan drivers can take on drinking water, get rid of wastewater, dispose of litter and perform maintenance on chemical toilets which most of these vehicles are fitted with," stated deputy governor Lubomír Traub, responsible for tourist in the region.



### New single trails at Hrubá Voda

The Hrubá Voda resort has expanded its number of downhill trails by seven, an increase of over 3km. The blue flow trail can be tackled by less experienced bikers. All of the technical elements on the blue track intended for jumping can be tackled even at slow speed. The red flow trail is ideal for more advanced riders who aren't afraid of time in the air. Tobogán is the name of the fast downhill trail with lots of banked turns and jumps. Enduro Rot is a less challenging trail with natural terrain featuring small jumps across rocks. On the other hand, Enduro Schwartz is for hardened bikers who can look forward to roots, rocks, steep sections and technical sections. Professionals are sure to enjoy the Jump Line with four large benches and the much-feared Downduro.


